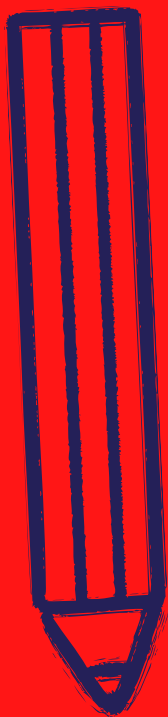


# PUBLISHING IN CHICANA/LATINA STUDIES DURING A PANDEMIC

***Chicana/Latina Studies: The Journal of Mujeres Activas en Letras y Cambio Social*** has served as the only peer-reviewed, interdisciplinary academic journal of Chicana/Latina scholarship. In addition to validating the knowledge produced by the Chicana, Latina, and Indigenous epistemologies, methodologies, and theorizations of its contributors, the editors draw from these very frameworks to forge a feminist editorial praxis that allows them to mentor the scholars who aspire to publish their work in the journal. This workshop will discuss the criteria and principles guiding the review and production process. It will provide steps, guidelines, and tips for submitting to *Chicana/Latina Studies* for graduate students, community members, creative writers/artists, emerging scholars, and senior scholars.
