



## 2021 Virtual Academic Writing Workshop October 22 & 29 10AM-1PM MST

*Chicana/Latina Studies: The Journal of MALCS* is hosting the 2021 Academic Writing Workshop online! Facilitated by former Chicana/Latina Studies co-editor, Gloria Cuadraz (2014-2017), this workshop seeks to cultivate scholarship that meets the mission of *Chicana/Latina Studies*: to publish groundbreaking interdisciplinary scholarship by and about Chicanas/Latinas and Indigenous women of the Americas.



Applicants must submit a final draft of a manuscript and a brief cover letter by **August 15, 2021 at 5:00 pm PDT** to [GLORIA.CUADRAZ@asu.edu](mailto:GLORIA.CUADRAZ@asu.edu) with the subject heading "Academic Writing Workshop Application 2020." Manuscripts must adhere to *Chicana/Latina Studies'* mission of publishing feminist Chicana/Latina scholarship to be considered.

The workshop will consist of peer review of all submitted manuscripts and two three-hour Zoom sessions. Up to six participants will be selected. Participants must be current paid members of MALCS.

Applicants will be notified of their acceptance by **September 1, 2021**.

Participants must provide evidence of membership in MALCS, and must commit to peer review and comment on all submitted manuscripts.

After the workshop, each participant will understand the internal publication criteria of *Chicana/Latina Studies*, gain direction regarding revision, and obtain first-hand knowledge of the journal's editorial production process. *Chicana/Latina Studies* also retains the rights of first submission of all manuscripts reviewed in the workshop. Since 2015, *Chicana/Latina Studies* has published 8 manuscripts that were submitted via the Academic Writing Workshop.
